1 **E/P #1TCiii 1851 3d Beaver Trial Colour Plate Proof in Black with Prominent Relief Break.** On India paper mounted on card, with SPECIMEN overprinted horizontally in orange. This proof clearly shows the vertical transfer “crack” extending from near the Beaver’s belly up to the letter P of POSTAGE, then splits right and left. This is clearly illustrated and described by Boggs on page 126 of his manual. Being a black proof, this relief flaw shows up particularly clearly. The India is cut into outer frameline at top, just touching bottom frameline and stained, else scarce and not often offered.


