- 1101** ☒ **1860 Registered Stampless Letter**, with single line Registered and single line Paid handstamps, Gainesville U.C. datestamp with manuscript date AUG.23.1860. With four backstamps which include nice strike of B & LHR West AUG.24.1860, Paris D.P.O. , Kincardine AUG.25.1860. Very fine.

- 1102** ☒ **1857 Stampless Cover with 4-Ring 51**. Mailed Brockville C.W. on MAY.20.1857 and rated "Paid" to Wellington. The rate was obliterated with a strike of the 4-ring numeral 51 cancel, then re-rated with a "3D" in circle. Light wear and staining at right and top, else a nice usage of this scarce obliterator.

- 1103** ☒ **1832 Fort Erie to Niagara Folded Letter**, mailed Fort Erie (Welland County) on 5.APR.1832 (manuscript dated broken circle, earliest recorded date for this) and rated 9d. No contents, few file folds, else a nice example of a scarce cancel. Ex. Graham.

- 1104** ☒ **1837 St Thomas Money Letter to Toronto**, mailed on 6.NOV.1837 (manuscript dated broken circle in bright red) with matching red PAID handstamp. Manuscript rated 2/3. Letter inside describes that it contained "seventeen pounds, five shillings". Light file folds, fine. Ex. Graham.

- 1105** ☒ **1823 Cornwall Straight Line on Folded Letter to York**, endorsed "Port of Cornwall" and cancelled CORNWALL straight line in dark red, with 4.NOV.1823 manuscript date below, also in red. Manuscript rated 2N9. Paper contains a beautiful large watermark of a seated goddess with crown, etc. File folds, fine.

- 1106** ☒ **1780 Quebec to La Canardiere, PQ Folded Letter**, delivered by favour. The letter is addressed to Dan(jiel) Galway who arrived in Canada in 1764 and lived in La Canardiere until his death in 1790. Galway was a court translator. Letter inside written by M. Lebrun, inviting Galway to dinner to discuss business. Very light overall ageing, very fine and early.

- 1107** ☒ **1826 Quebec to Montreal Steamboat Folded Letter**, manuscript dated inside 10.AUG.1826 and rated 9d in red. There is a light, but legible cursive "STEAM-BOAT" handstamp on front in black. Contains a two page letter in French. Overall fine, with light tape stain, else a scarce marking.



1109 ☒ **#24, 35a 1871 SQ + LQ Combination Cover**, mailed on 16.FEB.1871 at Montreal (two Berri duplex strikes) and addressed to Brome Corner, PQ. (Sweetsburg transit on back). Franked by a 2c Large Queen and a 1c Small Queen paying the 3c domestic rate. Very fine.

1110 ☒ **#27a 1871 6c Large Queen Cover to Maine**, franked with a very fine jumbo copy (tiny spot at left) of the yellow brown shade stamp (catalogues \$160 by itself) tied by an oval grid cancel. Mailed St George NB (APR.1.1871), with P.O. Saint St.... NB (APR.3.1871) broken circle on back. Slightly reduced at right and light overall ageing, else fine.

1111 ☒ **#27f 1868 6c Large Queen Cover to Albany**, franked with two copies of the black brown shade on thin paper (scarce thus), both very fine and tied by two strikes of the Peterboro CW Berri duplex dated OCT.29.1868. Tear at top, else a scarce franking and fine plus. Stamps alone catalogue \$650.

1112 ☒ **#34 1890 Henry Hechler Small Queen Cover to Germany**, franked with ten 1/2c Small Queens (block of four and strip of 6). Vertical fold at left and address is slightly smudged.

1113 ☒ **#34/44 Collection of Small Queen Covers, 1871 to 1890s**, with about 130 covers, franked with 1c, 2c, 3c, 5c and 8c. We note an 1876 (JY 3) 5c cover to England (perforated 11 1/2 and first year of use), block of 8 of the 1/2c on cover to NY, single 8c paying registration rate on 1894 (MR 1) cover to Sudbury, block of six 1/2c on cover to Victoria BC, etc. Lots of postmark interest, including duplex (many), small town broken circles, corks, two Ontario Street Montreal cancels etc. Quality varies, includes some fronts, etc. but mostly fine or better.

1114 ☒ **#35, 37, 39 1874 16c Pre-UPU Small Queen Cover to France**. Mailed Montreal on MAY.29.1874 and addressed to L'Hebergement-les-Cuisery, France (JUN.12.1874 receiver on back) via London (red PAID transit on front). Arrived France on JUN.11.1874 as evidenced by a scarce "ANGL." c.d.s on front. The 16c franking is comprised of two 6c, a 3c and a 1c (all have small faults). Back flap sealed with nice anchor in a red wax seal. Firby value guide rates this franking at \$1,000. Despite faults, still a nice franking and pre-UPU destination.

1115 ☒ **#41 1892 Illustrated Small Queen Cover**. Mailed Belleville on OCT.24.1892 to the post office inspector at Kingston and franked with a single 3c Small Queen. About half of the cover's front is illustrated with an advertising for the H. Corby Distiller company of Belleville. Picture shows a large industrial building with lots of smoke coming out of its chimney, depicting that business was good. Very fine.

1116 ☒ #51, 66, 74, 86, 87 1899 Uprated Registered Stationery Cover to Germany, mailed Berlin, Ont on 3.OCT.1899 and addressed to Bickel in Germany (via Toronto and England). Franked with a variety of period issues, totaling 10c paying the registered UPU rate. Several backstamps (3 different). A nice usage of the less commonly seen U10 stationery, ex. Boisclair and very fine.

1119 ☒ #69 1898 Fancy Cancel on Cover, franked with a 3c carmine Queen Victoria Leaf single, tied by a star in circle fancy cancel (Lacelle #976) from Forks Road, Ontario (broken circle dated MAR.28.1898). This Welland County post office closed in 1915. Very fine

1117 ☒ #53 1897 Montreal Colour Illustrated Cover, franked with a 3c Jubilee, cancelled by a Montreal Bickerdike Flag, addressed to Fraserville. The illustration is of a Mallard duck, from the Caverhill, Learmont & Co. advertising for Hazard Powder shells and ammunition. Colours are bright, and quite a fresh cover. Perfect for a flag cancel, or Jubilee or illustrated mail collector. Very fine plus.

1120 ☒ #77 1902 Toronto to England, Redirected to France, mailed on 10.NOV.1902 and addressed to London (receiver on back). Franked with GB 1 1/2d (perfin CS) to pay for redirection to Rue de Clichy in Paris. Missing back flap, else very fine.



1125 ☒ **1928 2c Admiral Cover**, to Belgium with Belgian Postage Dues totaling 2 francs and 65 centimes. Scarce and attractive. Some creases, especially at right. Est. \$100

1126 ☒ **1912 Around the World Admiral Postcard**, six countries include Germany, Egypt, India, Japan, USA and then finally Canada. Started out Pegau (Saxony), Germany MAR.10.1912, returned to Pegau from Toronto in 1912. Cannot see hub date, San Francisco backstamp MAY.21.1912. A wealth of cancels, about 20 and 3 redirection "labels". Well travelled so a little fragile. Est. \$400

1127 ☒ **1946-1997 Damaged/Mutilated Mail with Instructional Handstamps**, five interesting covers including damaged and delayed by fire, received in damaged condition, damaged in mail, violated street mail box with ambulance letter and cover. Est. \$100


1128 ☒ **POW #21 Espanola to Germany**, two items, one Free dated MAR.18.1942 and one uprated with 30c air mail postage dated AUG.19.1942. Both censored and reverse censor taped in Germany. Air mail cover has two thirds of letter sheet missing. Also other minor faults. Est. \$75



1129 ☒ **Redirected Cover with Two Black Out Cancels**, redirected Vancouver to Langara Island, BC, redirected to Prince Rupert then Ferrier Point, BC. Two black out cancels dated AUG.21.1945 on front and SEP.4.1945 on reverse. This is the last day of black out cancel use. Est. \$150



1130 **World War II Cover to Overseas Posting**, mailed SEP.5.1944 and returned to sender in Canada (backstamped) FEB.8.1945. 9 backstamps, with various F.P.O. cancels. **Est. \$120**



1134 **Prisoner of War Card Camp #133 Lethbridge, Alberta, to Germany**, censored with P.O.W. datestamp NOV.15.1943. **Est. \$75**



1131 **3c Cover to Denmark with Postage Dues**, mailed DEC.19.1936, Postage Dues applied in Denmark and the letter returned to sender in Canada with DLO Inspection Division MAR.3.1937 backstamp. Minor faults. Inspect. **Est. \$120**

1135 **J.A. Seeds Advertising Covers, early 1900's**, two different advertisements one in blue with 2c KEVII stamp APR.23.1909 and the second in black with 3c brown Admiral MAR.8.1919. Also a John A. Bruce Seeds advertising cover with 2c Admiral with duplex cancel APR.16.1912. Some minor faults. **Est. \$50**



1136 **#89, 90 1907 Redirected Cover**, franked with pair of 2c and a single 1c KEVII, tied by Montreal machine cancel. Addressed to London, England, where it was postmarked on back with London JAN.17.1917 c.d.s before being redirected to Alussio, Italy, where it arrived on JAN.19 per the Alussio squared circle on backstamp. The search for the recipient proved fruitless and the cover was returned to London (per a new return address that had been written on the back, replacing the Montreal address on the upper left corner which had been crossed out). The cover finally arrived at this destination JAN.22.1907 per the machine backstamp, having been routed through southern France on JAN.20 per the Alps Maritimes transit c.d.s. A striking cover, very fine especially given its extensive travels. **Est. \$100**



1132 **1/2c Printed Matter Postcard to U.S.A.**, with #74 tied with Ottawa JAN.29.1908 c.d.s. cancel. Unitrade CV \$300 if paying the circular rate. **Est. \$100**

1133 **Group of 4 Registered Covers, 1899-1900**, all to Rennie Seeds with four different 7c rate combinations includes Scott #68, 70, 75, 76, 77, 78 and 79. One with RPO O-118 backstamp (Rf 165). Some with minor creases, etc. Inspect. **Est. \$100**

1137 ☒ **#96, 145, 150 1928 Registered Cover to Haiti**, mailed Riviere du Loup on 13.NOV.1928 and addressed to Port au Prince Haiti (via New York). Franked with a combination of issues totaling 19c, overpaying the 4 oz registered foreign rate by 1c. Eight datestamps on back and bit of wear. Ex. Kimber Wald Gold Medal exhibit of the 1927 issue, and accompanied by a photocopy of his exhibit page.

1138 ☒ **#117 1923 Baldur Manitoba to Iceland Admiral**, mailed Baldur on 1.JAN.1923 and addressed to Reykjavik Iceland. Corner card is inscribed "Rev. F. Hallgrimsson". Franked with a 10c blue Admiral paying the UPU rate. Very fine and better destination.

1142 ☒ **#235, 241, 243-245 1942 Calgary Alberta Registered Money Packet**, Franked with a 5c Mufti plus various Pictorial Issue stamps totaling \$1.85. Stamps are tied by "Calgary & FDM R.P.O. No. 4" datestamps dated 2.JAN.1942. Card is from the Bank of Toronto in Calgary and was mailed to Clarendon, Alberta. Very fine.

1143 ☒ **#242 Re-Directed Registered Covers** with Scott #242. One Registered to Major Waller in India, backstamped D.L.O. among 17 various cancels between DEC.6.1939 and APR.24.1940, second cover Edmonton to Calmar, Alberta returned as recipient was deceased with nine 1943 backstamps.

1139 ☒ **#143 1927 Postage Due Cover to England**, mailed Lethbridge Alberta on 12.DEC.1927, arrived Llandudno on 24.DEC, refused and returned on 29.DEC. Franked with a 3c parliament, which underpaid the 6c Empire rate for 2 oz. 3d postage due applied upon arrival, plus several handstamps and notations: "3d to pay", "undelivered for reasons stated / return to sender", etc. Very fine. Ex. Kimber Wald Gold Medal exhibit, and accompanied by his write-up.

1140 ☒ **#143, 148 1927-30 (circa) Mackenzie King Mailing Label to Scotland, Forwarded to Bournemouth**, mailed Ottawa (undated roller cancel) and franked with a single 20 and pair of 3c stamps paying the 26c surface letter rate to GB. Address label has a heading "Office of the Prime Minister / Ottawa, Canada" and is initialed (in purple) by William Lyon Mackenzie King "WLMK / PM", prime minister of Canada at the time. Small faults from being removed from package, still scarce and desirable. Ex Kimber Wald Gold Medal exhibit, and accompanied by his write-up.

1144 ☒ **Small Box with 114 First Flight Airmail Covers, 1935-1938**. All franked with #C5, mostly cacheted. Includes to and return legs of flights, 72 Western flights and 42 eastern flights. Overall fine-very fine or better.

1145 ☒ **Group of 120 First Flight Airmail Covers, 1928-1931**. Housed in small box. All covers are cacheted and franked with #C1. A large array of flights which includes 69 Western flights and 51 Eastern Flights. Overall fine-very fine.

Couple of wrinkles at top and stamp damaged, else fine.

1147 ☒ **Group of 110 First Flight Airmail Covers, 1928-1931**. All covers with caches, includes matched sets of to and return legs of each flight. Overall fine-very fine.

- 1148 **1920's Semi-Official Air Mail Covers**, includes two APR.13.1928 Yukon Airways covers, an Oct. 1926 #CL11 Fairchild Air Transport First Flight signed by the pilot and a JUL, 1926 #CL13 First Flight cover.

Signed on back by R.A. Hadden, Postmaster Eastern Arctic patrol and with Inuit inscription on back as well.

- 1155 **Collection of Duplex Cancellations, 1900s to 1960s** all on stamp piece, hinged on 4 x 6 index cards. Most provinces are represented and we estimate a total of about 4,000 cards. Mostly all different, and when duplication is found, it is usually to show different time marks or early and late examples. Overall selected and fully readable strikes. The collection, as it has not been seen in over three decades, contains a great number of earliest or latest known dates, and even contains several only known or one of two or three known strikes. As an example, Alberta has 162 different, with 8 ERD and 16 LRD. Saskatchewan has 458 different, with 36 ERD and 29 LRD, Manitoba has 107 different, with 16 ERD and 14 LRD. Other provinces have a similar ratio of new dates. Overall very fine and not often offered.

- 1156 **Old Collection of Squared Circles on Stamps, Covers and Cards**, in two binders. One binder contains Type I cancels. We note here Rat Portage (x3), St Ann's, Shannonville, Dutton, Grimsby, Westville etc (28 covers and Cards). The other binder contains Type II cancels. We note a wide variety of towns, several very nice St John's NB illustrated covers, Formosa, Regina, Lindsay on 25 Map stamps, 6 different ASSA towns on stamp, Rosseau on 3c SQ, indicia errors, early and late dates, and many more better towns or stamp issues, etc.. We count 57 covers and cards, plus several hundreds of stamps. A nice collection and rarely offered in this quantity, quality and variety.

A better than average group, with selected cancels.

1167 **1812 Two Exchange Notes from Placentia**, one was filled out in 1812 and is for £40. Four names appear on it: Edmond Walsh, Mary Walsh, Thomas Browning and James Durney. The other is unused, and has similar text to the first, but has fancy engravings of men fishing in a small boat and trees. Bit of edge wear and creasing, else very fine and rare.


