## Canada Collections

** Mint Collection in Three Lighthouse Hingeless Albums, 1971 to 2005, an advanced collection in this time frame, which includes all the booklets, souvenir sheets, se-tenant multiples, coils, etc. We note many Fruit and Animal definitive perforation and paper varieties, all the Millennium issues and much more. Only a very few stamps missing and we note a few that are used. A great collection for continuation, or even for postage, as there should be well over \$800 included.

** Mint Collection in Three Volumes, 1968 to 2011, first volume contains 304 blocks of four (mostly plate blocks) 1970-97 (cv. \$1,100), second contains a collection from 1968 to 2004 with 347 different stamps, 131 plate blocks, 25 blocks, 45 airs, etc (cv. \$710) and third volume contains a collection from 2003 to 2011 with 190 different stamps, 70 souvenir sheets, 8 blocks, 6 booklet panes, etc (cv. \$710). All mint never hinged and very fine.

** 1974-1982 Canada Post Annual Collections, most are still sealed in Canada Post packaging. The 1974 collection has a Unitrade CV of $\$ 250$. Total face value is $\$ 72.28$.

** Group of Sheets and Part Sheets, all mint never hinged, roughly from the 1940s to the 1999 95c Christmas issue (two full sheets) and includes a good variety, plus Provincial Wildlife conservation stamp panes (these with face value of $\$ 336)$. We estimate just under $\$ 200$ in usable postage as well.

*/** Mint Collection on Lighthouse Hingeless Pages, 1897 to 1971, complete from 1937 to end, mix of hinged and never hinged at first, then gets to be never hinged only in the 1950s. A few of the early issues have faults, which are described in light pencil on the pages. Includes much better material such as NH 1938 Pictorial Set, NH 1942 War set, phosphor varieties, four 1970 Christmas centre blocks, etc. Also includes back of the book issues. Overall fine to very fine and clean.

*/** Group of Retired Circuit Books, with 10 from APS and 12 from RPSC, all retired in 1988, with mint stamps only (mix of hinged and never hinged), from QV to mostly 1970s. Appears to be all fine or better with lots of value still left. Should be worth \$40 to \$50 each.

- Accumulation of used on Pages, filling a box with probably a few hundred pages with used collections, from Large Queens to modern, with some better material (eg. note good Edwards, Admirals, some higher values, etc.) plus an album with about 160 used blocks and plate blocks. Some faults as expected, inspect.

- Lot of Mostly Used Stock, on Manilla pages in four binders (one being back of the book), with usually dozens or more of each, from Small Queens to Modern, thousands in all. Also includes a folder with mint and used sheets, some postmarks, and about a dozen Duck Stamp booklets. Also includes a Jarrett book, in almost new condition.

- Group of 8 Retired Circuit Books, from RPSC, all retired in 1988, with used stamps only, from QV to mostly 1980s. Appears to be all fine or better with lots of value still left. Should be worth \$40 to \$50 each.

○/*/** Group of Interesting Early Issues, with a \#4 with three margins, appears unused but has a pen cancel removed (accompanied by a 2017 Greene Foundation certificate). \#20 unused no gum. \#139 mint never hinged, with overinked surcharge (accompanied by a 2017 Greene Foundation certificate). \#124i very fine mint never hinged pair, with creases. Also Newfoundland \#77 used with faked Type C surcharge, a \#255vi imperforate pair with security punches, and \#87 mint pair with light gum disturbances.
$\odot / * / * *$ Collection of Stamps and FDC, starting with a Canada collection in a Harris album (strength in 1940s to 1970s), two annual collections (1977 and 1981), a collection of 400 first day covers from the 1970s and 1980s, including some House of Commons, and finally a stockbook containing a collection of plate blocks with matching FDC, from the 1970s and 1980s. Includes late 1980s animal series (unchecked for perf varieties), an upper left Regiments plate block (catalogues \$250), some sheetlets, booklets, higher denominations, etc.

-/*/** Collection of Mint and Used in Two Lindner Hingeless Albums with slipcases. Mostly used at first, starts to be mint in about 1950 to the end in 1983. Starts with Small Queens, Jubilees, etc. and many of the more expensive stamps may have faults or are off centre, still a decent offering. Mostly complete MNH from 1964 to 1983, missing a few stamps before that but still with good runs of Admirals, Arch, Leaf, etc. Back of the book is also well represented. Also includes a binder with mint and used stock from the 1950s to the 1970s in black stock sheets including some Revenues, Officials, etc. Condition varies, inspect.

-/*/** Lot of Estate Remainders, with interesting mint (including NH ) and used stamps plus covers. We note 19 covers and cards, with OHMS, orderly room, registered, small towns, Newfoundland, a registered cover from Toronto Sunnybrook, etc. A Bileski Winnipeg Tag offering on 7 stock pages that he retailed at $\$ 200$ (with his description page saying that the catalogue value at the time was \$400), a thick glassine full of tagged stamps from the 1950s and 1960s, 4 double sided stock pages with mostly better mint (appears to be mostly NH) items including G overprinted officials in plate blocks and singles, better coil pairs and strips, varieties, blocks of Air mail Special Delivery and more. Lastly is a box containing quality used, from a \#4 and 7 (both faulty), then LQs (faulty), nice selection of SQs to the 3c, QV Leaf set, hundreds of singles with socked on the nose town cancels or other clean cancels, high denominations in quantity, etc. A valuable lot worthy of closer inspection.

-/*/** Box Full of Mint and Used, mostly Canada, with lots of mixed material with many Small Queens, QV, Edwards, used high values and so on, Also many socked on the nose c.d.s. cancels, varieties, postage dues (including plate blocks), some covers, hibrite and fluorescent ink items, a nice group of perfins (some on cover) some foreign material, a 6c QV Leaf with St Thomas squared circle and lots more. Worthy of a close look. Some faults on early stamps, still overall fine or better.

$\odot / * / * *$ Mint and Used Collections, consisting of a Mason album to 1951 with good material, including decent Small Queens (to the 6c), Jubilees (to the 8c) and on, with a mix of mint and used and includes revenues and back of the book. Also a thick Scott album to 1988 with mint and used strength in the 1930s to end period. A Tudor Newfoundland album contains a decent showing with a few better items. A 3-ring binder contains mostly mint souvenir sheets and issues in the 43 c to 45c era in about a dozen double-sided stock sheets. Finally there is a stockbook containing uncancelled modern stamps, an air mail label collection and used stock from the 1960s to modern.

1016 •/*/** Mint Collection in Three Lighthouse Hingeless Albums, 1972 to 2010, with matching slipcases. Complete never hinged in period (missing a few stamps near the end) including all booklets, coils, phosphor, souvenir sheets, setenant multiples, perforation varieties (including better ones) and more, as per the Lighthouse pages. We note many Fruit and Animal definitive perforation and paper varieties, all the Millennium issues and much more. Should contain a very minimum of $\$ 1,100$ in postage (basic value of annual collections for this period), not counting all of the extra varieties, extra booklets, sheetlets, etc. A very clean and neat collection, very fine.

-/*/** Mint and Used Collection in Two Stockbooks, 1890s to 1980s with a collection of used and a separate collection of mint, hinged at first, then never hinged. Note lots of postage, good early issues, etc. Overall fine or better, inspect.

$1018 \odot / * / * *$ Mint and Used Collection in Two Volumes, mostly all hinged (some are in black mounts) onto Dominion of Canada pages in two binders, with pages up to 2004. An average collection which also contains NH souvenir sheets and a few booklets. Also comes with a Great Britain collection on home made pages, including a 3 margin \#1 Penny Black, some Austria, France, etc.
$\odot / * / * *$ Box of Odds and Ends, includes mint and used stamps, a selection of early booklets, a sealed Millennium Year Book, etc. Inspect.

$\odot / *$ Canada and USA Stock sorted into several hundred glassines, boxes full of bundleware, note lots of back of the book for Canada and USA, a few Commonwealth collections, a box full of worldwide sorted by country into envelopes, some mounts, three packs of Dennison hinges and more. ©/** Mostly Mint Collection, 1930s to 1980s on Manilla stock sheets, includes a lot of face value in sheetlets, blocks and plate blocks (mostly in the 17c to 32c range) but also some better early items such as a matched set of \#411 (never hinged), a NH block of 50c Oil Fields, never hinged Fisheries, etc. Inspect, mostly fine or better.

Also three shoe boxes with covers (including Small Queens), stationery, cur squares, box of mint never hinged postage from the 1970s and 1980s (Face is \$274), an Annual Souvenir book from 1974, a stock of used Newfoundland sorted in envelopes, (Scott 163 to 268, catalogued at $\$ 204$ ) and a collection of mint precancelled corner blocks, some with part warning messages, from Unitrade \#240 to \#591, including better such as 455xx, 458xx, 459xx, 460cxx, 586 , etc (high catalogue value on these).

Lot of Canada Post New Issue Posters, 1957 to 1972, with 10 different (but includes 19 posters, all but 4 are from $1957-$ 1958), all in black and white except those for the Kreighoff and Emily Carr issues, mostly all very fine and scarce.
*/• Mint and a Used Collection, each in its own Harris album. The used collection runs from Small Queens to the late 1980s, with some nice cancels, with some blocks, etc. The mint collection starts in the Arch era and goes to the mid1980s, appears complete from 1947-on, with little before that. Also included are two thick binders full of Manilla pages containing stock, from Edward to modern, sometimes with about a hundred copies. Lastly, we include an envelope full of worldwide in glassines, some modern USA used in a stockbook, two sheet files with several mostly USA sheets (and some Canada), as well as a group of USA Year Books from 1972 to 1986 plus three others.

$1025 \odot / * / \boxtimes$ Carton with Thousands of Stamps, in 2 albums, in stockbooks and loose on paper. Includes "bulk" packages of loose stamps, First Day covers including a 1962 Winnipeg tagged set, some catalogues and brochures as well as an attractive print of the 7c Edward.

$\odot / * / * * 1 / 273$ Collection of Mint and Used, 1851 to 1946. A very clean collection which we have left intact, as received, neatly displayed on quadrille pages with catalogue numbers for each stamp. Starts with a used \#1 and two \#4 (all cut into), then complete 1859s with shades, the numerous Large Queens have paper varieties and shades plus some watermarks, a Laid Paper 3c (faulty and not counted), Small Queens are extensive with shades, and includes many early printings, especially for the $1 \mathrm{c}, 3 \mathrm{c}$ and 10 c , some $11 \frac{1}{2} \times 12$ perfs, a few mint stamps including three \#43, a 3c shows a dramatic misperforation, some nice postmarks, etc. Up to here the majority are used plus a few mint or unused. The Jubilees, which are mint only go to the \$1 (latter is unused no gum, rest include some NH), then we start to see a used plus a mint (sometimes NH ) of every issue to the end, and is complete including coil singles, and includes some varieties such as "broken X", etc. The back of the book is complete for Air Mails and Special Delivery, and are all mint. Obvious faulty or reperforated stamps were not counted in the catalogue value, and we have noted them in pencil with an X. We have also noted which stamps were NH and have counted them as such. Also comes with a stockbook containing odds and ends - we note a never hinged \#09, some souvenir sheets, etc. An overall fine collection with many better centered, including many high values.

1028 •/*/** 4- Mint and Used Collection in a Minkus Album, 1852 to 1975 starts with a decent used \#4, good Cents, Large and Small Queens (mostly used up to there) then mostly mint hinged from QV Leafs until the end. No Jubilees. Some issues have no gum (for example, an otherwise nice appearing Québec set is without gum), and some of the high values (for example 50c KEVII is used). Some of the high values from the 1920s and on are lightly hinged (50c Bluenose, \$1 Parliament, etc.). We have counted as all hinged but there are probably a few never hinged here and there. Catalogue value is for up to 1950 only and includes G Officials, and other back of the book. We also note a page of mint PEI, etc. Overall fine, the obviously faulty were not counted and marked as such.

-/* 4- Mint and Used Collection in a Minkus Album, 1852 to 1988, starts with a 3 margin \#4, then nice mostly complete basic sets of Cents, Large Queens, Small Queens (these with printings, perforations, etc), QV Numerals and Leafs, Edwards, Québec Tercentenary, Admirals, Jubilees to the \$2 (missing \$1), then mostly complete to the end, with a mix of mint and used. Includes coils, perforated and overprinted Officials (some of these are missing), and most of the back of the book. Modern era also includes se-tenant multiples, booklets, mini-sheets and more. We catalogued only up to 1950 and should have a high catalogue value after that.

-/*/** 14- Collection on a Double-Sided Stock Sheet, 1859-1946, starts with Cents issues, Large Queens, Small Queens, Registration, Admiral War Tax, a mint never hinged lower right block of six of the $1 / 2 \mathrm{C}$ QV Numeral, some mint blocks from the 1930s and 1940s, etc. Includes a fine-very fine mint hinged MR2C which catalogues $\$ 120$ and was not included in the Scott catalogue value given. An overall fine or better lot.

$\odot / * / * *$ 14- Mint and Used Collection on Lighthouse Album Pages, 1859 to 1970, starts with a basic set of Large Queens (the 15 c is mint and includes thin paper, etc.), then Small Queens with shades and printings (incl. a few mint), then close to complete to the end, missing dollar Jubilees, a few singles here and there, the Scroll set and Special Delivery stamps. Mix of mint and used to about the 1940s, then mostly mint to the end. Mint stamps are assumed hinged except where noted and few stamps are marked as having no gum. Some obviously faulty stamps were not counted (and marked as such) and we note some never hinged (also marked) such as a 1c and 6c QV Leaf issues, a 2c purple QV Numeral, a 10c plum Admiral and a few more. Catalogue value is for up to 1951 only, and includes the back of the book present in period. Overall fine or better.

- 14/236 Stockbook Filled with Old Time Stock of Early Used, starts with a few 1c and 5c Cents, then Small Queens, with $12 \times 1 / 2 c, 45 \times 1 \mathrm{c}, 30 \times 2 \mathrm{c}, 122 \times 3 \mathrm{c}, 42 \mathrm{x} 5 \mathrm{c}$, plus a few 6 c and 8 c , followed by Jubilees $8 \mathrm{x} 1 \mathrm{c}, 6 \mathrm{x} 2 \mathrm{c}, 8 \mathrm{x} 3 \mathrm{c}, 4 \mathrm{x} 5 \mathrm{c}$, then QV Leaf issues with a dozen or more of each denominations (fewer for high denominations), and similar quantities for QV Numerals, , Maps, Edwards and Admirals to the 50c (some lower denominations have several dozen copies). We also note a few dozen War Tax Admirals (with many MR4, etc.) and some back of the book. Some mint stamps here and there, overall fine. Owner's inventory included (and scanned online).

$\odot / * / * *$ 15- Collection and Stock in Two Volumes, starts with a collection of straight edges in stock sheets, in an album which also contains various other material such as Québec Tercentenary issues, specialized Centennials, revenues, some Newfoundland and other provinces, etc. A second binder contains 18 Manilla stock sheets with stock from Cents, Large Queens, Small Queens, a few Jubilees and so on up to about the Mufti issue, with quantities up to a few dozen of some. Lastly is a group of glassines and stock cards with various material, some mint Fruit Tree perf varieties, a 1951 Post Office Presentation Folder with mint never hinged blocks of four, and over \$25 in modern postage (in booklets). Overall fine or better.

- 15/2688 Seven Full Red Boxes with Dealers Stock. With issues from 1859 up to 2013. Thousands of stamps in 102 cards with catalogue number and price. With some sets but mainly singles and often with more than one copy, we do note some issues with upwards of 10 copies. The last box includes back of the book issues, precancels, perfins, revenues and B.N.A. Generally fine or better, some small faults noted on the early issues.

- 21- Collection of Used in a Harris Album, starts with two $1 / 2 \mathrm{C}$ LQ, a few SQs, Leafs and Numerals and starts to show more stamps at the KEVII set. We note a lovely Québec full set, all very fine centered with large margins (Unitrade \$1,021), complete Admiral basic set, complete Scroll, and virtually complete (for regular issues) until about 1982. Decent back of the book includes overprinted G and OHMS Officials, provinces with a couple dozen Newfoundland and new Brunswick issues. Also includes three small albums, one of which contains several socked on the nose cancels, some back up stock, etc. A clean collection, overall fine or better.

- 21-30 Collection of 1868 Large Queens, all used, with $1 / 2 \mathrm{C}$ ( $x 4$, with shades), 1c first printing ( $x 2$ shades), 1c last printing ( $x 2$, both very fine), $2 c, 3 c(x 3), 5 c, 6 c$ ( $x 4$ with shades), $12^{1 / 2 c}$ ( $x 2$ shades), 15 c first printing ( x 4 shades) and 15 c last printing ( x 6 with shades). A few have small faults else overall fine or better group. Catalogue value is for all cheapest shade only, unchecked for watermarks, papers or perforations.

- 23/30 Group of Used Large Queens, with \#s 23 (with partial New Brunswick c.d.s., some faults), 24 (two copies, one with red London England receiver), 25 (two copies, one with Halifax H duplex obliterator), 27a (two copies, one with BC numeral 35 in grid, one with Montreal duplex), 28 (two copies, one with Halifax H duplex obliterator and creases, the other with Québec duplex and thins), 29 (with light duplex) and 30 (with HALIFAX straightline handstamps). A fine to very fine group.

- 35- Used Collection in a Minkus Album, 1870s to 1984, starts with Small Queens (including 20c and 50c), followed by Edwards, a page of 14 \#E1 shades including 6 copies with "no shading in value tablet", Admirals with shades and varieties, War Tax Admirals including MR2B, Bi, C and D, lovely Scroll set, page of $16 \times 20 \mathrm{c}$ Harvesting, plus three blocks of 4 , Arch with coil pairs, and so on until 1984. We note many extra shades throughout, as well as varieties such as "Broken X" (on 203i), "Burr on shoulder" and "Scarface" (on 3c Cartier), nice cancels such as "Pickle Crow" socked on the nose (dated first day of post office, FE 22, 1935). Includes back of the book, coils in pairs, booklet panes (no Admirals) and much more. Catalogued by owner up to 1954 only, as all very fine, which in some cases is a bit enthusiastic, still a lovely collection with attention given to quality.

- 35/1901 + BOB Used Dealers Stock, 1870s to 2001, hinged on pages and organized by Scott catalogue number in 12 binders. Duplication ranges from one of an issue upwards to $20+$ of others. Easily thousands of stamps which includes one book of all Newfoundland and another with back of the book issues. Also a small box with many hundreds of stamps in glassine envelopes, identified by catalogue number with lots of duplication. Note some faulty stamps in the earlier material but mostly fine or better.

1045 - 37/47 Collection of Used Small Queens and Widow Weeds, all on album pages and sorted as per centering (very fine, fine, very good) and then by cancel type, including squared circles, targets, double and broken circles, corks, RPOs, flags, etc. A nice collection which includes all the values from the 3c to the 50c. with 10c (x 18). 20c (x 6), 50c ( $x$ 5 plus a mint hinged).

- 35- Used Collection in an Album, 1890 to 1953, starts at Large and Small Queens, Jubilees (8 different values to the 50c), then mostly complete except for missing coils, (these start appearing in the Scroll issue-on). We note mostly clean material, with nice postmarks, etc. Includes almost complete back of the book issues in period. Also includes a second, empty (new) album plus a stockbook filled with stock from 1939 to 1980s.

High catalogue value, over \$112 in face value of the \$1.00+ issues.

- 66- Old Time Numeral and Edward VII Collection all neatly written up on 18 quadrille pages. A very detailed collection, with lots of postmark interest (note many Yukon, ASSA, fancy, etc.), precancels, booklet singles, some on piece or on cover, and more. Overall nice quality, with mostly low values and fine or better.

*/** 66-85 Queen Victoria Mint Collection, starts with the Leaf set ( $1 / 2 \mathrm{c}$ and 2 c are NH , the 10 c has no gum), then the Numeral set (the 1 c and 6 c are NH and one of the 2 c carmines is faulty and not counted), both Map issues follow (both are NH ) and ends with the two surcharges (both also NH ). Overall fresh group, all hinged unless noted, fine to very fine.

*/** 66/76iii Group of Queen Victoria Leaf and Numeral Mint Multiples, with Leafs: $1 / 2 \mathrm{c}$ (hinged block of four), 2c (never hinged block of four, plus a Plate 4 inscription never hinged strip of three), 3c (hinged block of four). Numerals: $1 / 2 \mathrm{C}$ (two blocks of four with 5 NH stamps) and 2c purple (never hinged block of four, with strong re-entries on top right stamp). Overall fine to very fine group. 2c (mint hinged) and 1c to 10c (used). Centered from fine to very fine, all with clean cancels. The $1 / 2 c$ has a small gum thin.

-/*/** 50/59 Collection of 1897 Jubilees, all on album pages, mostly used with values up to the 20c. The 1c to 3c values are sorted by cancel type, which includes rollers, datestamps, squared circles, c.d.s., flags, RPO, etc. Note a NH 1 c and a hinged 6 c and 8 c . Nice collection.

*/** 51- Mint Collection in a Stockbook, 1897 to 2003, starts with Jubilees (1c, 2c, 5c), 1/2c Leaf, 1/2c Québec to modern issues. Mostly lightly hinged up to about the Arch issues, then never hinged to the end. Owner counted 812 different stamps, 98 blocks (mostly plate blocks), 65 pairs, 11 strips, 24 souvenir sheets, 2 booklet panes, 15 complete booklets, etc. Owner's catalogue value is $\$ 2,180$ (with lower values not counted) and there is likely a high total usable face value included.

*/** 51/2031 Mint Dealer's Stock, 1897 to 2004, all identified, priced and sorted in four red boxes. Stamps range from Scott \#51 to \#2031, often with 2-4 copies of each issue, sometimes more. A mix of mint hinged and never hinged for the issues before 1950 then appears to be all never hinged. Note several items with catalogue values of \$50-100.
