

Welcome to Sparks Auctions Sale 33. Our firm continues to see a strong and steady increase in popularity, offerings and sale results, and this sale is again, our largest ever. Because Sale 33 is our first held in the new reality brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic, we want to protect our staff and customers and will therefore be holding this sale without a public floor. Viewing will be conducted by appointment only, and we will only accommodate a small number of people at once. Details of our COVID-19 Protocols can be found on our website.

We are proud to announce that the first part of this sale will feature Part 2 of the "Outaouais" collection of high-quality Canada and United States, with many certificates and great provenance.

The Outaouais collection was formed over a period of over 30 years, and consists of high quality, hand picked mint and used stamps and covers, bought one at a time in order to achieve a collection of the highest quality standards. The majority of the classics are accompanied by recent certificates, and many of the stamps also have excellent provenance. Many of the early mint stamps have original gum and will mostly be never hinged soon after. The used stamps were mostly chosen for their legible in-period postmarks, rarely seen on Pence issues, and if no c.d.s. was available then centering and appearance was purchased.

Part I of this sale was conducted by our firm on September 26th, 2017 and featured the first three mint stamps of the Canada collection, #1a, 2 and 3. The sale attracted much attention, as evidenced by the great prices realized, with the #1a (very fine unused) selling for \$75,900, the #2 (very fine unused) selling for \$61,100 and the #3 (extremely fine sheet margin stamp with original gum) selling for \$327,750, the highest amount paid for a Canadian stamp (these prices include buyer fee). This Part II offered here includes the rest of the Canada collection (up to 1950) as well as selected United States issues up to the 1940s including some graded and certified stamps. We hope you will enjoy this sale and that you will become one of the proud new owners of items from the Outaouais collection.

A reminder that lots that have a "Rsv" in the description are reserved, and the amount shown is the minimum bid accepted to open the lot. Also, our sales are always conducted in Canadian dollars, with an industry-low 17% buyer's premium. Our sales catalogues can always be downloaded by PDF on our website at sparks-auctions.com, or can be seen on SAN at stampauctionnetwork.com/ik/ik33/cfm, where thousands of high-quality scans and photos accompany. 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Province of Canada -- Pence Issues Scott #1-13



1849 Folded Letter Franked with 5c Red Brown Franklin Imperforate, mailed Montreal on DEC.14.1849 to Kennedy in New York. Since Canada had not yet printed its own stamps, it was permitted to frank this folded letter with an 1847 5c Franklin imperforate in Montreal, which is tied by a red "10" in circle. There is also a "4½" manuscript rate to pay for the Canadian portion of its voyage. Upon arrival in New York, the clerk crossed-out the 'PAID" and penned-in "Due 5". Long detailed letter inside, with two vertical file folds (one through stamp). A very fine example of this scarce usage, ex. Dale-Lichtenstein, Craveri and Daniel Cantor (2011), and illustrated in Boggs The Postage Stamps and Postal History of Canada on page 73. A great item to start any serious Canada collection.

• #1 1851 3d Red Beaver Imperforate on Laid Paper, used with centrally struck target cancel. A visually pleasing stamp with four large 2 and even margins, extremely fine. Accompanied by a 1991 Philatelic Foundation certificate and a 2020 Greene Foundation certificate.



3 🖂 #1 3d Red Beaver Imperforate on Laid Paper on Cover, mailed Bytown UC on JUN.26.1851 to Perth, with a light JUN.28 receiver in red, through Smiths Falls (JUN.27 transit in red). This cover is franked with a 3d red Braver imperforate on Laid paper, with large to huge margins, tied by a blurry target cancel. Cover has overall toning and aging, with creases on back but stamp is unaffected and very fine.



4 (*) #1a 1851 3d Orange Red Beaver Imperforate on Laid Paper. Canada's first stamp, engraved by Alfred Jones using a very similar design proposed by (later Sir) Sanford Fleming. This stamp has two certificates of authenticity: a 1985 Greene Foundation certificate stating "...Mint, O.G., genuine..." and a 2015 Greene Foundation Certificate stating "...#1a, unused, on laid paper, orange red shade, genuine in all respects". The gum was removed after 1985 to preserve the overall freshness and quality of the stamp. For the record there is a tiny faint crease entirely in the lower right margin which was not mentioned in either certificate; this could be literally cut away and there would still be four full large margins.

This very fine stamp with fresh colour and full margins is a very rare example of Canada's first stamp. It once adorned the Lindeman and the "Outaouais" collections, and was sold by us in part one of the latter sale in September 2017 for \$75,900 (including buyer's fee). It's new owner thought it fitting to re-offer it at the same time as part two of this lovely collection here, after a $2\frac{1}{2}$ year ownership. One census of unused mint laid paper three penny beavers puts the number at about 20. Although this might be a little bit low, unfortunately many of these mint and unused are cut into or have faults and some are in institutional collections. It is likely that fewer than a handful of very fine four margin mint number ones are available to private collectors. Rsv. \$30,000.



#2 6d Slate Violet Consort Imperforate on Laid Paper on Folded Cover, mailed Montreal on OCT.16.1851 to Philadelphia. This folded cover (no letter inside) is franked with a very fine and fresh, four margin 6d Consort on laid paper, cancelled with a light target cancel. There are a "CANADA" in arc, a "10" in circle and a "PAID" markings, all in red on front, alongside the red despatch datestamp. A very fine and appealing cross-border cover, with "Juliard" owner's handstamp on back, also ex. "Carrington" (2002) and Daniel Cantor (2011) collections, and accompanied by a 2011 Greene Foundation certificate.





E/P #3P 12d Queen Victoria Plate Proof in Black, on card mounted India paper, well centered and very fine. Accompanied by a 2016 Greene Foundation certificate. A premium example of this very scarce proof.

E/P #3Pi 12d Queen Victoria Plate Proof in Black, with Vertical SPECIMEN Overprint in Carmine, on India paper, well centered among four large and even margins, very fine.



8 E/P #3Pii 12d Queen Victoria Plate Proof in Black, with Diagonal SPECIMEN Overprint in Carmine, on India paper, with large to very large margins, very fine. Accompanied by a 2007 Saskatoon Stamp Centre certificate of authenticity. The diagonal specimen proof is rarely seen in this lovely quality, and several of the recorded examples have small faults.



9 (*) #4 1852 3d Red Beaver Imperforate, unused (no gum), with nice colour and crisp impression. A lovely stamp possessing four large to huge margins, very fine. Accompanied by a 1984 Greene Foundation certificate.

#4 3d Red Beaver Imperforates on Overseas Short Paid Cover, mailed Québec City on JUL.17.1858 to London, England, with red JUL.28 receiver on front. This blue cover is franked with two 3d Beaver imperforates, both with four large to huge margins and tied by the Québec datestamp. The rate is shortpaid 1½d, as it should have been 7½d but appears to have gone through undetected. The left stamp has a corner fault, else both very fine and the cover has a tear and some creases, still overall fine. Accompanied by a 1980 Greene Foundation certificate.

• #4c 1852 3d Red Beaver Imperforate on Soft Ribbed Paper, used with an APR.19.1858 datestamp. A nice stamp with fresh colour and four large margins, very fine. Accompanied by a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.



#4d 3d Red Beaver Imperforate on Cover, mailed from Québec City on SEP.3.1855 to "Hon'ble L.J. Papineau / Monte Bello / Petite Nation" with Monte Bello SEP.5 receiver and Montreal SEP.4 transits on back. This lovely blue cover is franked with a 3d Beaver imperforate, apparently from plate position B53 and on thin paper. Louis Joseph Papineau was a very well known politician. Very fine, ex. "Yule" and Daniel Cantor (2011) collections.

• #4v 1852 3d Deep Red Beaver Imperforate on Thick Hard Paper, used with a clear 4-ring #18 cancel from Kingston. This lovely stamp has four large margins, showing part of the next stamp at left and at top, extremely fine. Accompanied by a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.



* #5 1855 6d Slate Grey Consort Imperforate, mint with full original gum and bright, fresh colour. This stamp has three large to huge margins, bottom margin is irregular, still fine. A very rare mint stamp, especially with full original gum, accompanied by a 2008 Sismondo certificate and a 2011 Greene Foundation certificate. Very few mint 6d Consort retain the overall "bloom" of the stamp offered here, and fewer still retain their original gum 165 years after having been printed. Rsv. \$10,000.



#5b 6d Consort Imperforate on Cross-Border Cover, mailed Montreal on APR.1.1856 and addressed to Albany, New York. The cover is franked with a 6d greenish grey Consort imperforate with four large margins, just into outer frameline at lower right, tied by a target cancel in black. Tear on back flap, else very fine and accompanied by a 2005 Greene Foundation certificate.

• #5d 1855 6d Grey Violet Consort Imperforate on Thick Hard Paper, used with indistinct 4-ring numeral cancel. A lovely stamp with sheet margin at right (showing part of the imprint) plus three other ample margins, showing part of next stamp at top. A fresh and superior quality stamp, extremely fine, and accompanied by a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.

17 E/P #7Pi var 10d Cartier Plate Proof in Blue with Vertical SPECIMEN Overprint in Carmine, on India paper, this very fine proof shows characteristics of the major re-entry found in position 1, being a light line at the bottom of CANADA. Very fine.

* #7i 1855 10d Dull Blue Cartier Imperforate on Thin Crisp Paper, mint with full original gum, very lightly hinged. A truly lovely stamp with four large and fairly even margins, extremely fine. Accompanied by a 1953 RPSC (London) certificate and a 2007 Greene Foundation certificate. A rare stamp in this condition. Although there are a few other premium mint examples of the 10d Cartier recorded, virtually all of these are on the thicker white paper, rather than the delicate thin crisp paper. One would be hard pressed to find another premium mint original gum example on the thin crisp paper. Rsv. \$10,000.





* #8 1857 ½d Rose Queen Victoria Imperforate, mint with full original gum, lightly hinged. This stamp has very large side margins, others well clear to large, with very light toning in spots on front (not apparent on certificate photo), still fine-very fine. Accompanied by a 2004 Greene Foundation certificate.

21 • #8 1857 ½d Rose Queen Victoria Imperforate, used with Hamilton NOV.15.1858 datestamp, with two huge margins (showing part of imprint at top) and two clear to just touching, fine-very fine. Accompanied by a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.

* #9 1857 7½d Green Queen Victoria Imperforate, mint with full original gum, lightly hinged. A exceptionally fresh stamp which possesses four ample to large margins, bright colour and very fine. Accompanied by a 1968 Philatelic Foundation and a 2016 Greene Foundation certificate. A lovely stamp in all respects and ex. Julian Smith (1986). Rsv. \$9,000.



23 • #9 1857 7½d Green Queen Victoria Imperforate, used with light grid cancel and four well clear to large margins, showing part of next stamp at right, very fine. Accompanied by a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.

24 🖂 #9 7½d Green Queen Victoria Imperforate on Transatlantic Cover, mailed Montreal on AUG.13.1857 and addressed to Wakefield, England with AUG.27 receiver on back. Front shows a red tombstone "PKT LETTER / PAID / LIVERPOOL / AU 26 / A57" and back shows an unusual two line "BY-CANADIAN / PACKET" handstamp also in red. The cover is franked with a large margined (just clear at left top) 7½d green Imperforate, tied by a 4-ring numeral cancel. Overall very fine and accompanied by a 2001 David Brandon (Surrey) certificate.Unitrade \$6,000



25 * #10 1857 6d Reddish Purple Consort Imperforate on Very Thick Soft Paper, mint with large part original gum (rare thus) and three large to very large margins, and just touching outer frameline at bottom right, fine. A very nice example of this rare mint stamp, missing from even the most advanced collections. Accompanied by a 2005 Greene Foundation certificate and a 2007 Philatelic Foundation certificate, the latter stating "light staining below the right 6" which we qualify more as trivial and does not detract from this great rarity. Advanced collectors know how rare the 6d reddish purple on very thick soft paper is in mint condition, with most known examples having various faults. Finding a collectible example with original gum is a true rarity. Rsv. \$10,000.









(*) #11 1858 ½d Rose Queen Victoria, Perforated 11¾, unused (no gum), very fresh and well centered, extremely fine. A lovely stamp in all respects, accompanied by a 1986 and 2014 Greene Certificate. The ½d perforated is a relatively difficult stamp to find in mint or unused condition, with most recorded examples being poorly centered and;/or with faults. The example from the "Outaouais" collection possesses a near-perfect centering, a true condition rarity for Canada's first perforated stamp issue.



A scarce stamp in such nice condition, with fully intact perforations and fully dated postmark, fine-very fine. Accompanied by a 2012 Philatelic Foundation certificate.

* #13 1859 6d Brown Violet Consort, Perforated 11¾, mint with full original gum, slightly disturbed. This lovely stamp has deep rich colour and a crisp impression. A very well centered stamp as well, as even the nicest mint examples are often off-center. There are two clear intersecting guidelines in the bottom left margin, adding to the desirability of this stamp. A truly stunning stamp in all respects, quite fresh and very fine. Accompanied by 1966 and a 2007 Philatelic Foundation certificates, as well as a 2020 Greene Foundation certificate. Surely one of the nicest mint example of this rare stamp. Rsv. \$25,000.

37 * #15iii 1859 5c Red Beaver on Thick Paper, mint with full original gum, lightly hinged. A fresh and scarce mint stamp, very fine. Accompanied by a 1995 and a 2019 Greene Foundation certificate.

#17 10c Red Lilac Consort on 1865 Cover to Victoria BC, an attractive stamp, just tied to cover mailed from Hyde Park Corner U.C. with free strike of broken circle in red ink, with manuscript date OCT.28.1865, paying the 10c. rate to pre-Confederation Victoria, Vancouver Island with London U.C. transit cancel and pencil docketing "Received Dec 13th", cover professionally restored at left edge and very clean and attractive. Among the prettiest of the 15 recorded 10c. rate covers to Vancouver Island. Provenance: Daniel Cantor and illustrated at page 118 of Canada's Decimal Era 1859-1868 by George B. Arfken and Arthur W. Leggett. The cover was routed through London, Windsor-Detroit exchange and by closed bag across the continent to San Francisco and north to Victoria, for a total transit time of 46 days.

• #17, 17iii, 17v 1859 10c Red Lilac Consort Strip of Three Showing Two Major Re-Entries, used, each stamp with MAR.5.1867 manuscript cancels. The strip is from plate positions 41, 51 and 61, with the middle stamp showing a major re-entry (faint, mostly visible in the lower right "X") and the bottom stamp showing the "double épaulette" re-entry. Stamps are well centered and fresh, a rare multiple showing two major re-entries. Ex. Daniel Cantor (2011).

*** #17iv 1859 10c Brown Violet Consort with "String of Pearls" Variety,** mint with full original gum, hinged. This stamp shows a lesser impression of the variety, fresh and fine-very fine. Accompanied by a 1986 Greene Foundation certificate.

* #18 1859 12½c Yellow Green Queen Victoria, mint with hinged original gum and crisp impression. This lovely stamp has three very large margins plus a huge margin at left, very fine. Accompanied by a 1996 Greene Foundation certificate.



43 FEB.13 receiver, through Derby FEB.12. This tiny "Lady's" cover is franked with a fine 12½c Queen Victoria. Back has a few tears, still a fine cover.

** **#22b 1868 1c Brown Red Large Queen on Thin Paper,** mint, with full original gum, never hinged. A fresh and very fine stamp. **Unitrade \$4,800**

(*) #23 1868 1c Yellow Orange Large Queen, unused (no gum), exceptionally well centered among large, even margins, extremely fine. Accompanied by a 1983 Philatelic Foundation certificate. The 1c yellow orange has a tendency to be in unsatisfying quality when found in mint or unused condition. The example from the "Outaouais" collection displays exceptional attributes, starting with the centering, but also the full perforation, and the rich shade. A lovely stamp in all respects.



52 (*) #25 1868 3c Red Large Queen, unused (no gum), very well centered and fresh, extremely fine. A very nice stamp. Accompanied by a 2020 Greene Foundation certificate.



* #26 1875 5c Olive Green Large Queen, Perforated 11½ x 12, mint with full original gum, lightly hinged. A very fresh and nicely centered stamp, very fine. Accompanied by a 2004 Greene Foundation certificate.



(*) #27b, iii 1868 6c Dark Brown Large Queen on Watermarked Paper, with Major Re-Entry, unused (no gum), showing part of one letter of the watermark. The stamp also clearly shows the elements of the major re-entry from plate position 93. Pulled perf at bottom, still with deep rich colour and crisp impression and fine-very fine. This is the only known example of this combination of a watermarked stamp with this major re-entry, a must have for any serious collector. Accompanied by a 2005 Greene Foundation certificate. Finding an unused example of the 6c showing part of the Bothwell paper watermark is a rare occurrence, as there are likely 10 or less in existence. The fact that one example exists with the major re-entry is quite exceptional.

* #29b 1868 15c Red Lilac Large Queen, mint with part original gum, fresh and very fine. Accompanied by a 2003 Richard Gratton AIEP certificate.

Accompanied by a 1989 Greene Foundation certificate stating "staining at top", which we feel is too harsh.

(*) #33 1868 3c Red Large Queen on Laid Paper, unused (regummed) with bright colour, full perforations with pleasant centering, fine. One of Canada's rarest stamps, with fewer than 10 mint or unused examples recorded. In fact, of all the major numbered Canadian stamps, only the #2 and #31 are known in similar small quantities. This stamp is likely the second nicest example, with the original gum example in the Firth collection appearing to being the finest. Ex. Vadeboncoeur. Accompanied by a 2002 APS certificate and a (pink) 2010 Greene Foundation certificate. Rsv. \$10,000.

A lightly penciled X under a stamp means it was not counted in the catalogue value. We put a light pencil note beside more expensive stamps and put a total catalogue value at the bottom of each page to assist viewers.


