Canada Collections

- 1042** ☉ **Used Stock and Accumulation, From the Late 1800s to 2000s**, housed in one large carton. Consisting of tens of thousands of early to modern used issues, both on and off paper, with a good mix of commemoratives and definitives in four stockbooks, glassines, envelopes and "zip lock" style bags. During our cursory look, we noted, some precancelled, back of the book, revenues, as well as postmark interest and a quantity of bundleware from the Edward issue to the late 1960s. Mixed condition but overall fine or better. Close inspection could yield some surprises.

- 1043** ☉ **Lot of Used Stock, From Early 1900s to 1990s** consisting of thousands of stamps in glassines or envelopes sorted by issue. We noted strength in definitives including Centennials up to \$1, as well as flags and parliaments from the 1980s, some bundleware ranging from Admirals to War issues (low values), and hundreds of Québec law stamps with heavy duplication. Also included are hundreds of on paper in one shoe box, we noted many with nicer postmarks. Clean lot. (J.O.)

- 1044** ☉ **Group of 37 Bileski Offerings**, housed in glassines and consisting mostly of tagging varieties on definitives such as Centennial, Caricature and Parliament issues. Majority are mint never hinged with only 9 offerings being used. We updated many of Bileski's catalogue values to reflect current prices and most stamps are in the \$20 to \$50 range such as #455p T1 (CV \$50), #460fi (printed on gum side CV \$25), #591xx T1 (CV\$30), #592 T1 (CV\$50), #593 T1 (CV \$50), #704 T12 (no tagging CV\$25) and more. Useful lot for the variety collector, overall very fine.

- 1045** ☉ **Box of Various Interesting Items**, with sealed year books for 2004 and 2006 (face \$81), a collection of the 1979 17c Diefenbaker stamp (with stamps, various different FDCs including a silk Colorano FDC, a sheet, a few mailed usages, a CNR perfin, etc), a collection of 66 covers and First Day covers in an album (2007 to 2009), 4 mini-sheets of #585a (\$140), 4 mini-sheets of 585b (\$160), a collection of back of the book filling two double-sided stock sheets, consisting of overprinted G and OHMS (mint and used) plus a selection of red dues including varieties. Note a book "Strike, Courier and Local Post of the Elizabethan Era" by Earle Covert (1992), a group of 13 covers with Christmas stamp frankings. Last but not least is a collection of used singles and mostly blocks, plate blocks, etc on about 90 double-sided pages (1970s to 1980s).

- 1046** ☉ **Selection of Modern Issues and Back of the Book**, starts with a like-new Lighthouse hingeless album with pages for 1998 to 2006, containing a scattering of mint never hinged singles and souvenir sheets (including a complete set of the Millennium sheetlets of four), with a total of \$154 face value. Also includes a collection of mint and used back of the book on pages, with singles and blocks, some never hinged, etc with dues, special delivery, airmail and registration, all with a conservative catalogue value of \$2,150. Overall nice quality lot.

- 1047** ☉ **Dealer Stock of Back of the Book Canada Plus Newfoundland in 102 Cards and Dealer Pages**, with owner's retail prices totaling \$598 for Newfoundland, plus \$453 for the back of the book Canada. Majority of the material is mint, with many never hinged and centering is mostly fine for early progressing to very fine for later issues.

- 1048** ☉ **Lot of Mint and Used Collections and Stock**, starting with what appears to be a mint never hinged collection in mounts, housed in a Parliament album, mostly complete from the 1940s to 1978. Comes also with two used collections mounted in albums, from the late 1800s to 1977, with sparse representation in the earlier years then becoming more complete from the late 1930s onwards. We noted some back of the book such as airmails and postage dues, and a few Newfoundland issues. Also included are 5 annual collections from the popular 1974 edition to 1978 (complete in period), some precancelled warning strips of 20 from the Caricature issue, about 20 Canada Post souvenir items, a shoe box filled with used singles sorted by catalogue number in glassines with duplication up to 20 of each for some, a small lot of mostly used worldwide stock consisting 2 stockbooks and two small albums featuring issues from the British Commonwealth and U.S., as well as some philatelic supplies such as glassines and a few mount strips. Clean lot overall fine to very fine.

- 1049** ☉ **Mint and Used Stamp Collections and Stock**, starting with a mint collection in mounts housed in a Minkus album (1890s to 1979). We noted a mixture of mint and mint never hinged with only a few pages in the earlier issues, but mostly complete from the mid 1940s to the end. We noted highlights such as a Jubilee 15c (mint), Leafs (mint and used missing only the 10c), partial set of Numerals, complete Peace issue (all mint never hinged except for 10c), some back of the book including many official overprints like #011 (O.H.M.S. Oil Wells), O27 (\$1 Fisherman) both never hinged, and some revenues including mint Postal Scrips (1960s). One portfolio stockbook with what appears to be mint never hinged singles and some blocks of 4, from the Scroll issue (lower denominations only) to 1967, and a few airmails. Another collection consisting of mint and used in mounts also housed in a Minkus album from 1859 to 1972. We noted better such as #14 (unused), some used SQs, mint Jubilees (lower denominations), some mostly used Leafs, Numerals, Edwards, Québécois and Admirals, we noticed a used Bluenose, nearly complete Pictorial (missing 4c) and more. One binder filled with modern issues from 1973 to 1990, mostly complete for the period, two collections of mint and used, from 1859 to 1967, mounted on pages in a Stanley Gibbons Simplex Junior album, and one binder. We noted a used #15 (Beaver), and mostly partial sets throughout without the higher denominations, and 4 stockbooks with used SQs to the 1950s with some postmark interest.

- 1050** ☉ **Collections of Mostly Used With Stock**, starting with a small collection of used mounted on Minkus pages from the SQ issue to 1972. We noted a nice selection of Leafs, Numerals, and Edwards but no complete sets until we reach the Admirals (#105 1c, block of 8 MNH). The Back of book is represented with some special deliveries, airmails, officials. Stock of mostly used, is sorted by issue, and housed in 4 stockbooks, ranging from the War issue to the Landscape Definitives from the 1970s. We noted many used blocks of 4 with town postmarks, and duplication up to 70 of each for some. Clean lot.

1051 ☉/*/** **Valuable Consignment Reminders of Canada and Newfoundland**, starts with a mint and used collection in a binder, noting 5c SQ precancelled, mint Jubilees (1c, 2c, 5c, 8c), mint Québec Tercentenary set, used Scroll and Arch, starts to be all mint from Centennials to 1991 (about \$200 in modern face); a Bartlett letterhead illustrated with BNA stamps; complete sheets including a 1970 Christmas sheet and three Newfoundland sheets. A double-sided stock sheet contains mint never hinged items from the Jubilees to the Admirals (plus a few more, with a Scott catalogue of over \$5,000), 10 more stock sheets contain mint and used stock, from the Jubilees (with two 50c) to the Admirals (plus some more modern), an Albertville '92 FDC with signatures (athletes?), a poster signed by astronaut Steve MacLean, a box containing Newfoundland bundleware plus mint and used in glassines) and last but not least another box containing lots of interesting mint and used Canada, saw an inverted 6c airmail surcharge (with BPS certificate), precancels, plate blocks, revenues (including unemployment insurance, a used FSC4 \$175), and more. Lots of value in this one, a close examination is recommended to better appreciate. A great lot for the online reseller.

1052 ☉ **#4- Used Collection in a National Stamp Album, 1852 to 1935**, starts off with two #4 (different shades, one has a corner fault), selection of 9 Large Queens, selection of 15 Small Queens with extra shades, various Jubilees to the \$2, and probably 70% complete from there to the end. Also includes a stock page full of NB and NS stamps and another two filled with PEI and NL stamps (mint and used), as well as 5 NS covers from 1860 to 1865 and a page of Kaulbach Island strips. Overall nice quality collection.

1053 ☉/*/** **#4/1256 Mint and Used Collection and Stock**, starting with a collection from 1850s to 1989, with many in mounts, housed in a Paris Graphics album. Mostly used and scattered representation from #4 (Beaver) to the Edward VII issues with faults, then higher degree of completeness from the Admirals onwards going from a mixture of mint and used to mint never hinged in the QEII era. We noticed some back of the book with airmails, special delivery, postage dues and Official overprints. Includes one stockbook filled with a mixture of mint and mint never hinged singles, blocks and coil strips, from a variety of issues (Leaf to Centennials). Also included is a small amount of postage (about \$30) consisting of mostly booklets as well as some used Admirals housed in envelopes and modern off paper. Clean lot, overall fine to very fine.

1054 */** **#4/320 Valuable Mint Collection in a Lindner Hingeless Album, 1852 to 1952**, starts with a 4 margin #4, #7 (rebacked proof, not counted), 6 different Cents issues, 10 different Large Queens, 15 different Small Queens, complete Jubilees, and complete for regular issues from #27 to 320, including coil singles. Also included is strong back of the book, with complete air mails, complete overprinted officials (G and OHMS), complete registration, complete dues (to 1965), and complete special delivery, plus 6 different War Tax. A lovely collection which includes many never hinged stamps (even the more expensive items, but the catalogue value of \$44,549 is for all hinged only, so actual will be much higher). The overall quality is very nice, with the odd regummed early issues, and there is oxidization on a few orange or red stamps due to the album used, still overall fresh and fine to very fine, with many of the latter. 1055 ☉/*/** **#9/103 Selection of Early Mint and Used**, with #s 9 (used with barely any margins but nice 4-ring #27), 15 (used on thicker paper), 30c (15c Large Queen on very thick paper, used with tiny tear at right), 50 (mint never hinged block of four), 70 and 71 (both mint never hinged), 96-103 (mint set with hinge remnants) and E1 (lightly hinged with blue-green shade). Overall fine group.

1056 ☉/*/** **#14- Canada and Great Britain Collections**, starts with a Canada collection in a Jarrett album, 1859 to 1973 with a good variety of material including early issues (some faults in those) with Cents, Large and Small Queens, Jubilees to the 8c, Bluenose, etc, generally used with some mint scattered in here and there. Also an old "Canadian postage Stamp Album" with pages to 1899 published by the Canadian Stamp Company in Québec city, with Large and Small Queens, Jubilees to the 8c etc plus some back of the book including older revenues. Note a sheetlet of "poster stamps" from the 1939 Royal Visit, still in their original package (priced at 1c cents) as well as two complete 8c Kreighoff sheets. Also includes a Great Britain collection in a like-new Windsor SG album, with stamps from 1840s to 1973, mostly used but with mint scattered-in here and there. Overall good representation in this, but nothing expensive noted.

1057 ☉/*/** **#14- Valuable and Impressive Mint and Used Collection, 1859 to 1971**, in a Lighthouse album with slip case. Most of the collection is represented with both a mint and a used example tucked underneath. Starts off strong with Cents issues including shades and papers, followed by equally strong Large Queens (basic mint set plus several used, including 5 watermarked stamps, noting a plate inscription block of 6 of the 15c), useful Small Queens include an imperforate pair of the 1c (faults, not counted), includes all values with shades such as four 10c, etc. 2c to 8c Registration (total of 6 mint stamps), mint Jubilees to the \$2 plus a \$5 (thin), complete mint Leafs, Numerals, Edwards, complete used Québécois (mint to the 15c), complete mint Admirals with lots of extras such as lathework, coils, part-perforate blocks, imperforate pairs and blocks, 2 pages of Admiral War Tax, and appears complete to the end, including all the back of the book, coil singles and pairs, etc. A great collection for the dealer or collector alike. Most of the material is fine to very fine but there are small faults here and there, especially in the earlier period. See our many scans online. Rsv. \$7,000.

1058 ☉/✉ **#14- Collection of Used, from 1859 to 1976**, mounted in a Harris album starting with some First Cents issues (#14, 15, 17, 18), several LQs (missing 1c), SQs (complete set), several Jubilees (lower denominations), Leafs, Numerals and Edwards (complete sets), some Québécois (lower denominations). Appears complete from the Admirals onwards (including Scroll issues with Bluenose and Parliament). Some back of the book representation with airmails, special deliveries, postage dues, war tax, official overprints and late Newfoundland issues. Also included are 35 federal wildlife stamps on permit (1985 to 2004), over 160 FDCs from the 1970s to 2004 including a few special event covers, unused stationery (approximately 100 items), and Harris supplements from 1973 to 1998. Clean lot, overall very fine.

- 1060** ☉/*/** #14/60 Group of Early Mint and Used on Three Stock Pages, with Cents Issues, a few Large Queens, Small Queens and Jubilees, with a mix of mint and used, including some never hinged. Noted NH blocks of four of the 2c, 3c and 5c Jubilees. Several stamps have faults, in the form of trimmed perfs (in the unused Cents issues group) and thins or creases, etc, still an overall fine group. All are scanned on-line.

- 1061** ☉/*/** #14/2582 Mint and Used Collection, From 1859 to 2012, housed in a 4 hingeless Unity albums. The earlier stamps are mostly used, such as the First Cents issue (#14, 15, 17x 2), LQs (3c, 6c, 12½c, 15c x 2), SQs including the higher values (20c and 50c), then a mixture of mint and used and mostly complete sets from the Leaf issue onwards. We noted that stamps are generally mint from 1947 to the end with gradual presence of mint never hinged as we progress through the modern issues. The catalogue value up to 1951 (#302) is \$4,600 (stamps with obvious faults not included). We conservatively counted the face value not including denominations lower than 17c, and came up with a total of \$1,066. We noted a good selection of high value definitives (up to \$10), P stamps, and souvenir sheets. Clean lot, overall very fine. See scans for a glimpse of the content.

- 1062** ☉/*/** #14/1926 Collection of Mostly Used, From 1859 to 2008, mounted on Minkus pages, housed in 6 albums. The collection begins with the First Cents issue (#14 x2, 15 x4), a few LQs (6c x3, 15c), a selection of about 40 SQs with a variety of values, Jubilees (1c-10c, 8c is mint), complete Leaf set, many Numerals, Edwards, and Québécois, Admirals are complete, and more. We noted that there are many duplicates throughout, souvenir sheets, nice town postmarks, a small group of town precancels, private perfins and some mint and used Newfoundland from 1880 onwards. The collection appears well advanced, missing only a handful of stamps including the back of the book, and the later issues. Also included are over 40 thematic collections from the 1980s to early 2000s. Usual condition.

- 1063** ☉/*/✉ #14/2177 Mint and Used Collection, from 1859 to 2000s, mounted on Harris pages (up to 2007) in a thick Uni-Safe album, mostly used especially in the early issues, such as First Cents with #14, 15, 17, 18, and 19, several LQs (1c to 15c), SQs (complete set, 1c is mint), some Jubilees (½c-5c, 15c and 50c all mint except for 1c and 2c), Leafs (complete set), Edwards (complete set), several Québécois (mint ½c, 3c, and 10c), Admirals (complete set), some Scrolls including the Bluenose, and more. Sparsely filled from the 1980s to the end. We noted some back of the book representation, such as official overprints, registration (8c mint with fault), mint and used New Brunswick (#6-10) as well as mint and used Newfoundland with over 40 stamps from 1880s to 1940s. Also included are about 220 first day and event covers housed in 3 albums, from the 1990s to mid 2000s. Clean lot, overall very fine.

We noted a nice selection of the First Cents issue, with some duplication (missing only #16), several LQs including the 2c, 6c and 15c value (x3 mint), some SQs up to 50c (mint #38 and 40), a few Jubilees (including a very fine \$2), Numerals (up to 20c), Edwards including the 50c value, the complete set of Québécois (mostly unused), Admirals (\$1 x2), Bluenose (x2), and many other 50c and \$1 values up to the Peace issue. All stamps are used unless noted. Clean lot, overall fine to very fine, with a high catalogue value.

- 1065** ☉/* #14/614 Collection of Mint and Used With Stock, From 1859 to 1973, in mounts or mounted in a White Ace album, starting with the earlier used such as the First Cents issue (#14,15,17), followed by a basic complete set of LQs, then a mixture of mint and used from SQs to the Admirals (many without gum), but no complete sets until we reach the late 1920s. We noted increased completeness with mint stamps from the 1930s onwards. The Back of book is represented with postage dues, airmails, special deliveries, and officials. Stock of used, is sorted by catalogue number, housed in 1 binder with issues ranging from SQs to the 1970s. We noted duplication up to 10 of each for some. Many faults in the Victoria era material, still overall fine to very fine.

Sparsely filled with earlier issues such as First Cents (#14 and 15), LQs, Jubilees, Leafs, Québécois, then increasing completeness onwards to the end, with the Admirals and Scrolls being complete (including the 50c Bluenose and \$1 Parliament), etc. We noted some coils, booklets, back of the book such as airmails, special deliveries, war tax, and more, even a few nice town postmarks. Clean lot, overall very fine. See scan for a glimpse of the content.

- 1067** */** #15- Valuable Mint Selection, 1859 to 1956, filling three stock sheets, with two #15 (with and without gum), 24, good selection of Small Queens including a block of 6 of #43, Jubilees complete to the 50c, group of better Leafs and Numerals, Edwards to the 10c with extra shades, two different Admiral reversed essays, group of better Admiral issues including coils and back of the book including air mail, special delivery, dues, registration and war tax. We also note a #190a (Cartier imperforate pair never hinged) and #363 with major mis-perforation, etc. Huge catalogue value and nice overall quality, with a mix of hinged and never hinged. - 1068** ☉/* #15- Collections of Mint and Used Plus Stock, starting with a small collection of used mounted on Scott pages from the First Cents issue (#15, 17) to 1953. We noted 5 LQs (½c is mint, 3c, 6c, 12½c, 15c), a nice selection of Leafs, Numerals, and Edwards but no complete sets until we reach the mid 1930s. The Back of book is represented with some war tax, postage dues, officials, and a few Newfoundland stamps. The second collection consists of mint and used from the late 1800s to 1972 in mounts, and is featured in a Darnell album. We noted sparse representation until the mid 1950s. The third collection of mostly used from 1898 to the mid 1990s is mounted on pages and housed in a Parliament album with sparse representation throughout. Stock of mostly used, sorted by catalogue number, housed in 5 binders with issues ranging from the Admirals to the mid 1990s. We noted duplication up to 5 of each for some. Also included are about 30 Canada Post souvenir articles, mostly from the 1960s. Useful lot, overall fine to very fine.

- 1069** ☉/* #15/649 Mint and Used Collection, From 1859 to 1974, housed in a hingeless Ka-be album. The collection has a mixture of mint and used throughout, starting with used #15 (Beaver), LQs (3c and 12½c), then increased representation with SQs (6c with dot on left '6' printing variety), Leafs, Numerals, Edwards, and Admirals, Bluenose etc. We noted many complete sets from the late 1920s to the end. The catalogue value up to 1951 (#302) only is \$1,543. Some faults in the earlier issues which were not counted, else overall fine to very fine.

- 1070** **⊙ #25/652 Collection of Used in a Schaubek Album, 1868 to 1974**, with emphasis given to clean c.d.s. cancels, many being socked on the nose and fully dated. A good representation in period, from the Large Queens-on, including many complete sets, better stamps, often with more than one copy tucked under, etc. Includes back of the book, intertwined throughout and note some degree of specialization in the Centennial issues, phosphor issues and more. Overall quality is nice and well worth a close look to better appreciate the pages we have not scanned. A great collection to expand on.

- 1071** **⊙ #34- Stockbook Full of Used**, first page is full of Small Queens (½c to 8c) plus two dozen 2c registration stamps, followed by an assortment of different issues up to the modern times. Of note are several pages of Centennials (to the \$1) and a page containing a set of 18 mint never hinged Postal Scrip issues and ends with several pages of mostly GB used issues. Also includes a lot of over 500 3c brown Admirals used on small piece, useful for postmarks, varieties, etc. Overall fine to very fine.

- 1072** **⊙/*/** #34- Highly Documented Collection of Mint and Used Stamps, from 1890s to 2003, housed in 25 Thick Binders**, consisting of complete sheets, souvenir sheets, booklets, blocks, plate blocks, and singles, in mounts, on home made pages, noting a few better stamps such as used #60. The earlier issues are for the most part used with the odd exception such as 2c Jubilee (mint block of 4), but becoming increasingly mint and never hinged from the late 1940s onwards. The collection features specially prepared pages with in-depth description for each issue, accompanied by many color photocopies (see scan for an example). We noted some tagging and perforation varieties, as well as some better such as #226 (50c Victoria Parliament) and 227 (\$1 Champlain Statue) in mint never hinged singles, #271 matched set of mint plate blocks (20c, Pl 2, Peace Issue), 272 LL mint plate block (50c, Pl 1 Peace Issue), and more. The face value was carefully counted by the owner and adds up to \$1,865. During our cursory look, we detected a faint odor of tobacco. Great collection to build on.

- 1073** **** #34/56 Group of Mint Never Hinged Queen Victoria Issues**, from a recent new find, includes ½c Small Queen (x8, including a block of four), 3c Small Queen (single with faults, not counted) plus the following Jubilees: 1c (x26, including blocks and multiples), 2c (x14, including blocks and multiples), 3c (x33, including blocks and large multiples), 5c (x12 in two blocks) and 8c (marginal single). All fresh and mint never hinged, the odd stamp might have a light crease or bend, else overall fine or better.

- 1074** **⊙/*/** #34/2146 Mint and Used Collection, From 1870 to 2005**, in mounts or mounted in 2 Scott Specialty albums with matching slipcase. Mint and used throughout, with the earlier stamps predominantly used, starting with the SQs. We noted that the collection is quite advanced with mostly complete sets (except for Jubilee and Québec issues). We noted that stamps are generally mint from 1953 to the end with gradual presence of mint never hinged as we progress through the modern issues. The catalogue value up to 1951 (#302) is \$3,588 including a nice selection of B.N.A. and back of the book stamps such as airmails, special deliveries. We conservatively counted the face value (not including denominations lower than 17c), and came up with a total of \$575. We noted a good selection of high value definitives (up to \$8), booklets and souvenir sheets. Clean lot, overall very fine. See scans for a glimpse of the content.

- 1075** ***/** #34/139 Dealer Stock of Early Mint Issues in Thirty 102 Cards**, with Small Queens (to the 50c), Jubilees (to the 50c), some Numerals, Edwards, Québécois, Admirals and Dues. We note many very fine centered stamps, never hinged and mostly a fresh group. The cards are all retail priced to a total of \$9,439 (catalogue value is higher). Viewing is highly recommended to better appreciate the value in this lot.
