No appointment is necessary on sale day. Viewing these lots is essential, as we know there will be many "finds" awaiting the curious viewer. 35	4	Stamps	4 medium plastic tubs filled with worldwide (with some Canada) on paper and off paper stamps. Some are sorted by countries in envelopes.
36	1	Covers	1 carton filled with over 400 first day covers (1970s) from Scandinavian countries such as Denmark, Iceland and Greenland, housed in 4 binders.
37	1	Covers	1 carton filled with over 400 first day covers (1960s and 70s) from Scandinavian countries such as Norway, Sweden, and Faroe Island, housed in 5 binders.
38	1	Stamps	1 carton filled with Canada mint and used collections and stock from late 1800s to 1970s. Noted some revenues and back of the book.
39	1	Stamps	1 small box filled with roughly 25 Canada Post thematic or annual collections (1960s-70s) including a 60th anniversary of QEII Coronation cover and coin, as well as Millenium (6) and NHL (2) coin and stamp sets.

43	1	Covers	1 carton stacked with over 1,000 Canada covers (owner's count) from 1911 to early 1990s, with a great variety of town cancels from coast to coast, with lots of postmark interest.
44	1	Stamps	Box with small accumulation of useful mint never hinged Canada stamps from late 1940s to 2012, with total face value of \$190 (owner's count including 65 "P" values). Stamp denominations of 5c or lower not counted. Noted many plate blocks with the earlier issues.
45	1	Stamps/ Covers	1 carton filled with Israel collection and stock from 1948 to 1980s, housed in two partially filled albums, and two binders. Also included are over 40 first day covers from the 1970s.

46	1	Covers	1 carton filled with over 1,300 Canada first day cover (owner's count) from the 1960s to 1990s, including over 350 House of Commons and Senate covers from the 1970s to 1990s (size #10). Great variety of frankings. Many in sleeves.
47	1	Stamps	1 carton filled with dealer stock of mint and used Canada in 3 volumes and loose manila stock sheets. Noted many classics with postmark interest, then onward to the 1990s, including a good amount of mint never hinged. This lot should yield some finds to the dedicated collector.
48	1	Stamps	Canada mint hinged collection in one binder, from late 1800s to late 1980s. Over 500 stamps mounted on about 40 homemade pages. Includes a small selection of back of the book and Newfoundland. Good value in this one.
49	2	Supplies	2 cartons filled with empty Canada albums, two Lindner albums, gently used stockbooks, and one red box filled with used 102 cards. Useful lot.
50	2	Stamps	2 shoe box size containers filled with many thousands of Victoria, Edward and George V era stamps, on and off paper, sorted by issue and housed in glassines. Should yield some finds to the dedicated collector.
51	1	Stamps	1 carton filled with tens of thousand of Canada used stamps from George V to modern "P" stamps, with many sorted by catalogue number, housed in glassines. Should yield some finds for the dedicated collector.
52	1	Stamps	1 carton containing 5 Canada used stamp collections from classics to the 1990s. One of the collections is housed in a gently used Lighthouse album with pages from 1851 to 1994 with some back of the book.
53	1	Stamps	1 carton filled with tens of thousand used Canada stamps from the Victorian era to 1990s, displayed in 6 volumes and manila stock pages, as well as two red boxes.Many sorted by catalogue number. Clean lot that should yield some finds.
54	1	Covers	1 binder with roughly 70 first flight covers, some pilot-signed, mostly Canadian, but also saw a few USA. Also noted a few Canada #135 (50th anniversary of Confederation) on cover.
55	2	Stamps	2 cartons containing a worldwide mostly used collection in 5 Master Global Albums, classics to the 1970s. Pages are about half full with light duplication. The classics have faults as might be expected with the rest of the material overall fine to very fine.
56	3	Stamps	3 cartons containing a large worldwide accumulation with classics to the 1980s, in several stockbooks and older album pages, including an 'A' to 'Z' collection with extra material on loose-leaf pages, souvenir sheets in a stockbook, a few older world stamp albums, stamps on stock pages, etc. Overall fine or better.
57	1	Stamps / Ephemera	1 carton of eclectic remainders: Canadian Revenues (including full sheets of some Customs Duty stamps – 1c x2, 2c x3, 5c x2 and 10c x1; stock sheets and several envelopes of used war tax and excise stamps); a stockbook with some Precancels; a few old documents; and a few small black line prints of Maritime scenes. The lot is rounded out by several sheetlets of Winnipeg-Pembina Courier Service labels and covers.

58	1	Covers / Stamps	1 carton of modern postal history of Hungary, Austria and other European countries and a shoebox of worldwide stamps mostly off paper.
59	1	Stamps	1 carton of Canada, mostly used though we saw mint hinged and never hinged also. These include Queen Victoria to Official issues (both OHMS and G overprints), with a bit of everything in between. Regular issues to the 1980s. Partly collection, partly accumulation or dealer stock, we saw postmark potential. Stamps are in a Scott album, on loose pages and in glassines. We also saw new issue posters with stamps affixed and postmarked, including on the first day of issue.
60	2	Postcards	2 cartons containing 3,800 postcards (owner's count) mostly European (Sweden, Denmark, Belgium, Switzerland) as well as WW1 and London.

73	1	Stamps	1 carton of USA containing 3 red boxes plus a half red box of used, 2 boxes used on 102 and 105 cards and 1 box of perfins.
74	2	Stamps	2 cartons containing thousands of mostly used worldwide stamps in 6 large albums. A bit of everything here and ideal for collectors looking to fill gaps in their own albums. Fun for many hours!
75	1	Stamps	1 large carton with thousands of mostly used worldwide stamps in 9 old-time albums, some from the 1930s. Sure to be some interesting finds lurking in these pages.
76	2	Stamps	2 cartons of many thousands of mostly used USA in 17 albums/binders/stock books, a mint sheet file and a box. 85	1	Stamps	1 carton containing several thousand used worldwide stamps in 11 photo albums. Random checks showed that the stamps lifted off easily from the pages. There are also 2 sparsely filled old time stamp albums.
86	2	Stamps	2 cartons containing many thousands of used worldwide stamps in 13 albums and binders plus 1 red box.
87	2	Stamps	2 cartons containing many thousands of used worldwide stamps in 23 albums and binders.
88	2	Stamps	2 cartons containing many thousands of used worldwide stamps in 26 albums binders and on pages.

89	1	Stamps / Supplies	1 carton of worldwide stamps in Tari-fold pages plus a Tari-fold holder. Also includes worldwide stamps (China, Japan, Mongolia) on loose pages and in presentation packs.
90	1	Stamps	1 small carton containing a dealer counter book of USA classics. Many condition problems but probably some finds to be had also.

96	2	Stamps	2 cartons with thousands of worldwide stamps in albums, binders, loose pages and manila stock sheets. We also noted sheets in a couple of sheet files. Sure to be a fun romp for the collector who likes to sort and fill gaps in their collection.
97	1	Stamps	1 carton with many thousands of used Canadian Centennial stamps sorted by denomination into bundleware packets from the 1c to the \$1.00. Many, many hours of study ahead for the buyer of this lot. Also includes several Centennial Stamp Boxes, some in their original packaging.
98	7	Stamps	7 bins / boxes of well over a hundred thousand Canada used off paper from the Admirals through George VI and into 1990s Elizabethan era, a considerable amount of it in bundleware. This will provide many, many hours of fun hunting for varieties and postmarks. Ideal to share with friends and club members or for the eager reseller.
99	8	Stamps	8 bins / boxes of well over a hundred thousand Worldwide used (mostly) off paper from the 1930s to the 1990s, a considerable amount of it sorted into envelopes and identified. This will provide many, many hours of fun hunting for varieties and postmarks. There is also a fun box of USA Elvis b&w promotional photos with the Elvis stamp postmarked on them. Ideal contents to share with collector friends and fellow club members or for the intrepid reseller.
100	1	Stamps	1 carton of thousands of both mint and (more) used worldwide and Canada stamps in stockbooks, Tari-fold sheets and loose pages. A good project for the collector who loves to sort!

101	1	Stamps / Covers	1 bankers box of interesting collection remainders including used from Small Queens to modern, with Peace Issue sheet/multiples, Admiral covers, a van Dam Revenue catalogue and some First Day Covers. Many c.d.s. postmarks and other interesting items, including a Cycling thematic pack (t-shirt, etc. in a can from Canada Post). We also noted a group of Winnipeg-Pembina 1980 courier service full sheets.
102	1	Supplies	1 carton with 4 Lighthouse L4-32 stockbooks, these having sixteen double-sided white pages. One is still shrink-wrapped and the other three show no sign of use at all. Retail price for these is over \$176. Ready to house your other Sparks Auctions Floor Sale purchases!
103	1	Covers	1 carton of Canada FDCs from late 1960s to early 1990s in binders and loose. Mostly Canada Post Official FDCs, except for the 1960s items. We saw plate blocks that will be of interest to the avid FDC collector.
104	1	Postal Stationery	1 large carton of USA Postal Stationery from the 1890s to about 1990 in large binders with a few loose. Bulky but beautiful, this lot would make an excellent start on this interesting are of USA collecting.
105	1	Covers / Stationery Post Cards	1 plastic box with a mix of modern FDCs (mostly 1980s to '90s) in a FDC album, on Vario pages and loose, plus a FDC album with Stationery Post Cards from the Victorian era, in which we saw some a couple of squared circles. Also includes a small pile of revalued Queen EII stationery and a bundle of the ST-1 experimental Christmas labels from 1983.
106	1	Stamps	1 large carton of mainly British Commonwealth stamps including 4 stockbooks of Caribbean & Southern Africa which is a accumulation of pre-1980s stamps sorted into 28 envelopes by country: Jamaica, India, Bermuda, Bahamas, Bermuda etc. There is also Brazil, an old-time Cardinal album and a smaller box of GB commemoratives on paper.

- 3. The bidder with the highest bid acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the buyer. The term "hammer price" means the last bid acknowledged by the auctioneer. The purchase price payable by the buyer will be the sum of the hammer price plus a commission equal to 17% of the hammer price ("buyer's premium"), together with any tax which may be applicable.
